 - Strong knowledge in core subject areas and/or technical CTE content and the ability to explain concepts clearly.
 - Excellent communication and interpersonal skills including the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, instructional staff, and parents..
 - o Ability to understand and follow oral and written directions.
 - o Patience, empathy, and a commitment to helping students succeed.
 - o Organizational skills and the ability to manage multiple tasks effectively.
 - o Work confidently and with discretion.
