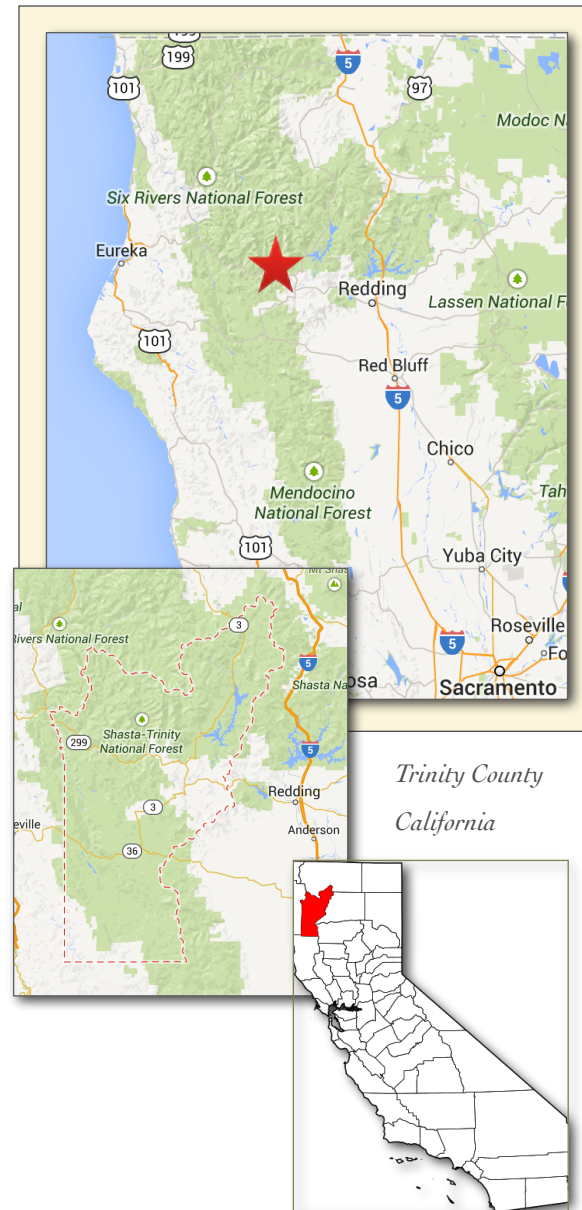


Characteristics of the Ideal Candidate

- Will prioritize the creation of a safe and healthy classroom and school community
- Is able to conduct holistic Bio-Psycho-Social assessments through observation and interviews with family and appropriate service providers
- Coordinate and provide a strengths-based, holistic, systems approach to case management and mental health services for children 0-18 and their adult support system
- Provide services that have focused attention on developing skills of parents, teachers, and caregivers, as well as supporting the mental health of adult family members as needed
- Provide services in/with the child's settings at school, home, and/or community
- Facilitate Family/Student Study team Meetings and case management
- Has used and trained in conflict resolution skills and restorative practices
- Is a good listener with an open mind who understands how to help students have a voice, share opinions, and respectfully disagree
- Provide short-term therapy and evidence-based interventions as needed
- Willing to participate in staff development activities, workshops, and conferences to expand professional knowledge and skills
- Uses standardized practices and/or methods; leading, guiding, and/or coordinating others; operating with a defined budget
